

Zambia shipment 2010

The first Zambia shipment for 2010 is on its way.

After a short delay while the technical centre in Lusaka relocated, the first 2010 shipment of computers to Zambia is finally on its way. Along with the standard packages of Pentium iii and iv computers with CRT and flat screens, there were a number of special deliveries. Included in this shipment were three boxes of IT text books covering word processing, spreadsheets, presentations and databases, which were kindly donated by Westonbirt school, Tetbury, Gloucestershire.
