Our Approach

In Africa, ITSA is committed to putting in place the infrastructure necessary to ensure the computers reach the intended beneficiaries and are used effectively.

Key elements of our approach are:

- Working with the government to ensure the computers clear customs without excessive charges
- Vetting schools to ensure they are genuine and are ready for the computer (security, power etc)
- Undertaking teacher training if necessary
- Providing technical support
- Putting in place arrangements for end-of-life recycling

ITSA achieves these objectives by setting up its own organisations or working with local partners.

Country Programmes

ITSA has its own country programmes in Malawi, Zambia and Zimbabwe and works with Finnish NGO Pro-Kenia to send computers to Kenya. These programmes are focused on distributing large numbers of computers to state and faith-based schools.

We have also partnered with many organisations, to reach more children and help transform IT literacy in Africa. Watch how we worked with Microsoft, to help network 3 schools in just 48 hours..
